About the Studio

Home & Found is a London-based Architectural Interior design studio, founded by Tamsin Saunders in 2013. Alongside our design practice, we run an online antiques shop offering one-of-a-kind antiques.

The studio undertakes only a small number of interior projects at any one time, allowing Tamsin, as Principal, to remain closely involved in each project and to work hands-on with the team to execute the creative vision.

Home & Found's work spans a range of styles but is always rooted in sensitivity to the client, the architecture and the wider landscape. The ambition is to build an inspiring and varied portfolio, exploring a broad range of styles that respond thoughtfully to both the building and its inhabitants.

Guided by Tamsin's naturalistic sensibilities the studio's design philosophy emphasises natural materials, craftsmanship and heritage. We prioritise sourcing from the existing rather than the new, and art plays a central role in our process, reflecting Tamsin's background and passion, and bringing emotional depth and individuality to every project.

Above all, we aim to create beautiful, interesting homes which nurture a sense of well-being, understated elegance and simplicity - beautiful yet relaxed, warm, inviting and truly personal.

Role Overview

We are seeking a well-rounded Mid-Weight Designer with a minimum of four years' experience to join our team. In this role, you will be confident working across the full project life cycle closely with Tamsin, with particular strength in technical documentation, AutoCAD drawings, and FF&E procurement.

You will be involved in all stages of the design process and comfortable managing multiple projects simultaneously. The role suits someone who is highly organised, adaptable and confident working within a fast-paced studio environment. Strong technical design skills are essential, with experience taking projects from initial concept through to completion, alongside excellent presentation and communication abilities. A background in architecture would be advantageous.

The successful candidate will contribute to the continued growth and development of the studio as part of a small, collaborative team.

Responsibilities

- Work closely with Tamsin to support scheming, sourcing and sampling activities.
- Oversee the delivery of presentations to clients.
- Manage FF&E and interior architectural elements across all project stages, from initial concept through to procurement and installation.
- Prepare and manage comprehensive schedules. (Lighting, Hard Finishes etc.)
- Produce technical drawings such as floor plans, elevations, joinery and bespoke furniture.
- Liaise with clients, suppliers, contractors and consultants as needed.

While these are the core responsibilities, the role also involves exposure to other areas of the studio, requiring a flexible and proactive approach.

Ideal Candidate

- At least 4 years interior design experience in the high-end residential market. Architectural experience is a bonus.
- Enthusiasm for interior design and working knowledge of the interiors industry.
- A team player with attention to detail and strong organisation skills.
- Adaptable to changing priorities and proven experience multi-tasking.
- High level of proficiency in AutoCAD or Rhino 2D, Photoshop and Microsoft Office. Experience with Estimac is a bonus.
- Experience with all elements of FF&E design, specification, management and procurement.
- Confident in interpreting, reviewing and producing technical drawings, including plans, elevations, sections, details, and fitted joinery and furniture.
- Confident leading meetings and attending site visits independently.
