You will play a key role in ensuring our designs are buildable, accurately documented and successfully executed on site.

The Role

- Produce comprehensive technical drawing packages using AutoCAD.
- Produce GA plans, furniture layouts, elevations and reflected ceiling plans.
- Prepare lighting, electrical and switching layouts.
- Produce detailed bespoke joinery drawings.
- Prepare bathroom, kitchen, stone and tile drawings and details.
- Produce and maintain project schedules and specifications, including lighting, sanitaryware, ironmongery, finishes and appliances.
- Maintain drawing registers and accurate version control.
- Coordinate technical information with architects, contractors, consultants, suppliers and specialist subcontractors.
- Review contractor and specialist shop drawings.
- Issue and revise drawings and schedules throughout construction.
- Respond to technical queries and RFIs.
- Attend site and coordination meetings where required.
- Assist with site coordination, installation and snagging.
- Help manage project information and programming to keep projects on track.

- Strong technical drawing and detailing skills.
- Advanced proficiency in AutoCAD.
- Experience producing full tender and construction drawing packages.
