- Assist with site visits, installations and project coordination.
- Style interiors for photography, filming and marketing.
- Support product development and creative collaborations.
- Contribute to Studio Banjo's social media, brand storytelling and creative content.
- Help keep multiple projects organised, moving forward and beautifully executed.
