### **Brief Development**

- Build on space planning and volumetric studies developed during the pre-commissioning phase.

- Develop room and furniture layouts based on sound ergonomic principles, creating logical, well-ordered and well-proportioned spaces.
- Ensure practical storage solutions are prioritised and that appliances and equipment locations are well considered and fit for purpose.
- Observe all relevant fire, mechanical and electrical requirements.

### **Furniture & Joinery Detailing**

- Develop furniture and joinery moulding strategies for all assigned projects.
- Ensure scale and proportion are balanced, well considered and consistent across the scheme.
- Resolve details so that every element respects the architecture and material context of the building.

### **Joinery Specifications**

- Nominate and specify appropriate and in-budget appliances and equipment, ironmongery, lighting, worksurfaces, sanitary ware, and interior and exterior materials and finishes that meet the client's brief.
- Record these clearly and keep them updated on project specification forms that are visible and accessible to colleagues.

### **Artichoke Design Outputs**

- Develop consistent, standardised Artichoke design information in the form of concept design drawing packages that correlate with the joinery specification documents.
- Evolve the design in response to client feedback and with input from the Creative Director and Design Director to a level where Artichoke can confidently contract against it.

### **Specialist Items**

- Oversee specialist subcontracted items such as metalwork, upholstery, ceramics, glass and decorative artists.
- Ensure the form and function of these elements meet the client's brief and align with the creative vision for the interior.

### **Creative Oversight**

- Maintain consistent oversight of the design development beyond the contracting stage.

- Monitor and review design changes arising from production or other factors to ensure the integrity of Artichoke's design language is maintained.

### **Collaboration & Teamwork**

- Communicate clearly and concisely with all internal and external stakeholders.
- Produce, or help produce, well-articulated documents for clients in line with Artichoke's brand values and identity.
- Lead by example in behaviour and dress for all internal and external meetings.
- Prepare and issue all necessary project information in good time for project milestones and handover meetings, ensuring the quality of work is consistent and delivered within agreed deadlines.

### **Time Management**

- Consult with key stakeholders at the outset to agree a realistic number of hours for concept design and brief development.
- Ensure design hours remain within agreed budgets and that work is completed in good time for required project milestones and handovers.
